Description:	It is proposed to add minimum 2 years of post-PhD experience must for the registration of a new supervisor to maintain the quality of research.			
Resolution:	Approved with the suggestions by the board that the applicant will continue to do his research, publish the paper in good/renowned journals and try to get research projects. during the two year of award of Ph.D. degree. Further, after 2 years of post-PhD and registration as supervisor in BTU, he/she will be allowed to supervise students as co-supervisor for next 1 year and demonstrate the research guideline capability before he/she entrusted as independent supervisor.			
Agenda Item A6.9:	To approve the minimum time of 1.5 years for thesis submission after the appointment of Co-supervisor.			
Description:	It is observed in some cases that co-supervisors are being added near the thesis submission by the student. So, a guideline of timeline need to framed for it. It is proposed that a PhD research scholar can submit his/her thesis after a minimum of 1.5 years after the appointment of Co-supervisor.			
Resolution:	Approved in addition that the research scholar must have at least one indexed journal paper with the newly appointed co-supervisor.			
Agenda Item A6.10:	To consider and confirm the closer of Research Center of MBA at SGI, Sikar.			
Description:	The purpose of establishing the research centre of MBA at SGI, Sikar is to avail the good academic support to the research scholars who are pursuing their Ph.D. but this purpose has not been fulfilled from the institute end. The University has enquired the actual status of Research Supervisors at the centre of Management of your institute, but there was no satisfactory response received from your side. One of the Research Supervisor, Dr. Karuna Jain has left the institution but this has not been			

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	informed to the University. The students under her guidance were being harassed as they were not properly informed about clear status of their supervisor.
	It is also proposed to transfer and reallotment of supervisor to all the students at research Centre of Management, SGI, Sikar to another BTU affiliated colleges /constituents college, allotted by the previous orders and allotted by order No. F (45)/BTU/Dean Research/2022/311, dated:11/5/2022. Annexure-9.
